

## **Aquatic Weed Hauler Job Description**

Weed hauling begins the week before Memorial Day Weekend and the last pickups are made the week after Labor Day. Weed Hauler must be available or arrange to have weed hauling coverage throughout the pick up season.

Aquatic Weeds need to be removed from the lakeshore by the property owner and put on the edge of the road. Only aquatic vegetation will be picked up.

The weed hauler must supply appropriate equipment (probably a pickup truck and/or trailer and pitchforks) to collect and transport weeds.

Weed Hauler must deposit all weeds at designated site on Lake Mitchell or an approved site of the weed hauler's choice.

The weed hauler must make his/her own arrangements for insurance liability as the Lake Mitchell Improvement Board has no policy covering weed haulers or their actions.

The weed hauler will collect aquatic vegetation according to the following schedule:

**Monday** - Section 1# - Canal north to the roller rink.

**Tuesday** – Section 2# - Roller rink along West Lake Mitchell Drive checking all lakefront roads and courts ending with the Camp Torenta loop.

**Wednesday** – Section 3# - Canal south and west including all roads with lake front property to end of Sunrise Point Road.

**Thursday and Friday** - Days for collecting weeds not picked earlier in the week.

Send sealed bids to Lake Mitchell Improvement Board, 203 Peninsula Dr. Cadillac, MI 49601 by January 15. Bids should not exceed \$8500.

Bids will be opened at the Lake Mitchell Improvement Board meeting on January 30, 2010.

All bidders will be notified within 48 hours of the meeting regarding which bid was chosen..
